He is an advocate for creating greenspaces for underserved communities in an effort to confront the vastness of food deserts in urban environments.

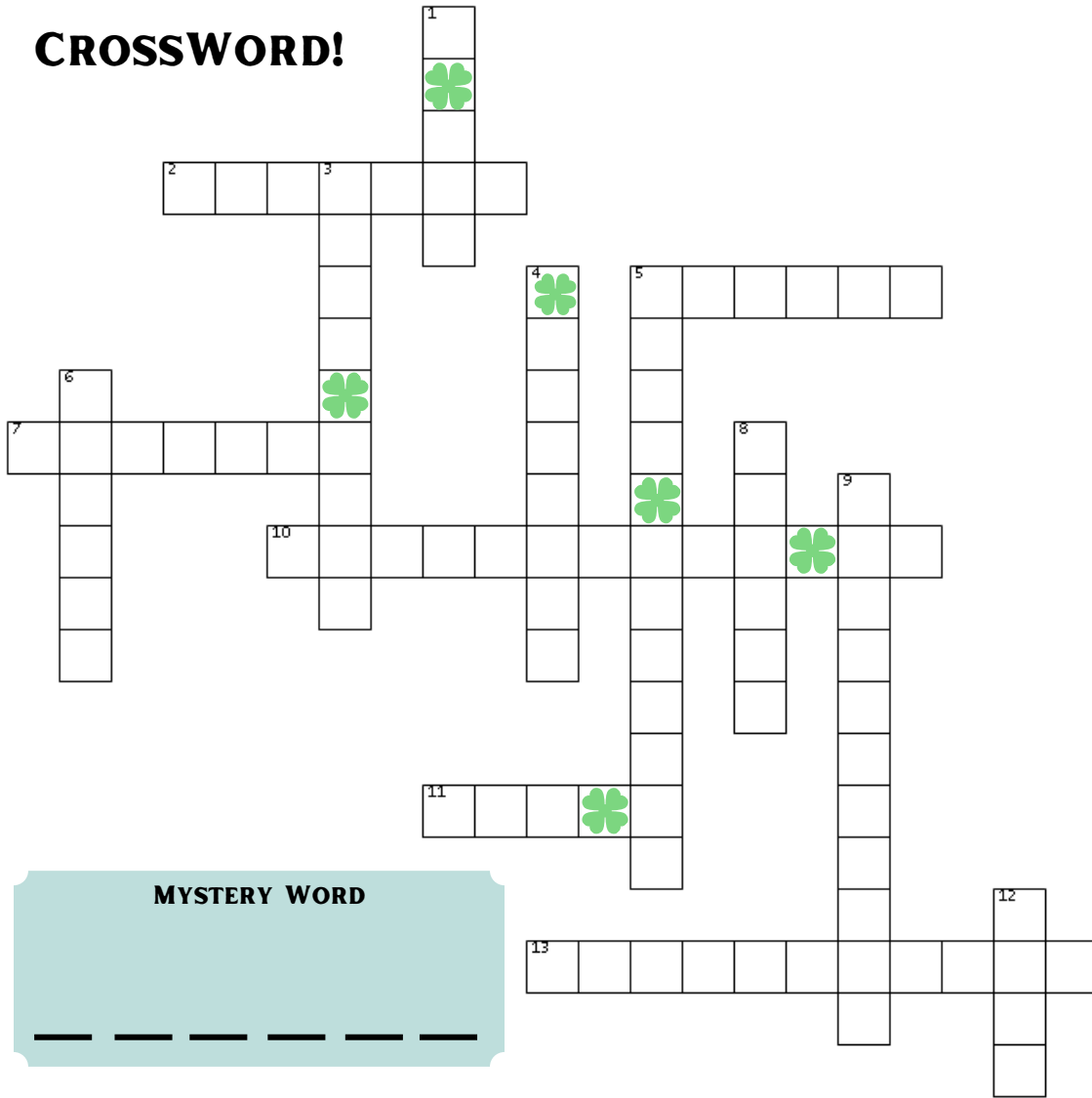


Jane Goodall
